



Overview: A Level Drama and Theatre – AQA

Students will complete assessed work on devising theatre for component 2.

They will continue work on their own acting skills using scripted extracts to showcase their abilities to an external examiner.

They will study a second set text in a new theatre style and revise the first one, ready for examination. They will watch another piece of professional theatre and complete notes in preparation for the written exam.



Year 13 Drama

Term 3:

You will complete rehearsals for extract 3 (scripted performance).

You will perform this to an external examiner and complete the reflective report for hand in.

You will revise both texts and continue to practice your theatre review skills ready for the written examination.

Term 1:

You will complete your devised piece of drama and perform it for assessment, You will complete your working notebook, analysing the process.

You will study your second set play text which will be in a contrasting style to text 1. You will analyse the social, cultural and historical context in which it was written and the theatrical style associated with it. Detailed character understanding will be developed through practical work exploring the text and you will begin to consider your ideas for how you might direct, act and design the play. You will also practice writing responses to exam standard

Term 2:

You will work on 2 monologues/duologues or group scripts for performance, fine tuning skills in characterisation, physical and vocal expression and sensitivity whilst creating tension and emotion for an audience. You will apply the methods of Stanislavski to your work and write a reflective response about the process.

You will continue to explore both set texts and practice exam style questions.

You will watch another piece of theatre and continue learn how to analyse the different production elements. You will practice exam style questions
