## Re: National Lockdown

The Prime Minister's announced last night that schools will be closed from today to the majority of students until further notice.

In line with our Home Learning, Guidance for Parents & Students, from Wednesday 6 January 2021, all lessons will be "live."

Based on the number of students who have attended school today (0.08%) we are working on the assumption that the vast majority of our parents / carers are able to facilitate safely student's home learning. In most cases, the safest place for children is now at home.

We would therefore ask that school places for the children of Critical Workers and Vulnerable Children are prioritised based on the needs of each family. Priority will therefore be given to those families where:

- Children are on a Child Protection Plan or Child in Need Plan
- Children have an Education Health Care Plan
- Both parents are Critical Workers
- A single parent is a Critical Worker

They will be required to bring their own headphones, where possible, and will work in ICT rooms accessing our "live" lesson provision. They can attend wearing non-school uniform.

Students will need to *remain onsite at break and lunchtimes* and food can be purchased from the Tower Block canteen.

On Wednesday 6 January 2021 they will need to arrive at 8.30am and line up on the back playground so that we can take a register and allocate ICT rooms.

### “Live” Lessons

Will commence from 8.50am on Wednesday 6 January 2021. There will be no requirement for students to attend Tutor Time at the present time.

Lessons will be delivered at the following times:

- Period 1: 8.50am - 9.50am
- Period 2: 9.50am - 10.50am
- BREAK: 10.50am - 11.05am
- Period 3: 11.05am - 12.05pm
- Period 4: 12.05pm - 1.05pm
- LUNCH: 1.05pm - 1.45pm
- Period 5: 1.45pm - 2.45pm

Teachers will continue to follow the subject areas Curriculum Plans, making adaptations where appropriate. So, in theory, there should be limited “lost learning” and all students should be able to continue to progress with their academic studies.

The Prime Minister also announced it would be unfair for academic examinations for Year 11 and Year 13 to place this year. Vocational examinations (BTECS) will still take place. Until we know the details of how students will be assessed it is imperative all Year 11 and Year 13 students continue to attend “live” lessons.

Student engagement will continue to be monitored by teachers and any concerns reported home. Teachers will also provide feedback to students in the following ways:

#### Teaching & Learning Routines - Virtual School

1. **Teachers** will acknowledge students work online on a weekly basis by using as a minimum, the “private comment” facility on an online platform. **Students** will respond - if appropriate. \*
2. **Teachers** provide High Impact Teacher (HIT) feedback, a mark and a comment, to **students** on at least two\*\* assessments per ½ Term by using as a minimum, the “private comment” facility on an online platform.
3. **Teachers** will identify SPAG errors in assessments by using as a minimum, the “private comment” facility on an online platform. **Students** will correct SPAG.

\*once every 2 weeks @ KS3 for foundation subjects.

\*\*once per ½ Term @KS3 for foundation subjects
