Dear Parent / Carer,

Re: Proposed Re-Integration of Students and Staff from Monday 6 September 2021

The Department for Education released new guidance to schools on 6 July 2021. I am writing to outline what our *proposed arrangements* are - noting these are *proposed arrangements* because at the time of writing nothing is definite and further Department for Education announcements over the summer period could change our plans. Should the *proposed arrangements* change we will notify you via InTouch email.

We continue to work hard to keep Headlands School as safe as possible. At the request of the Department for Education, we are required to offer x 2 Lateral Flow Device (LFD) tests to all students and staff (in school) in the first week of our return in September 2021.

Students will be required to self-administer a swab of the nose and throat; results are shown within an hour.

The timings / days for students to attend for their **1st LFD** will be:

Year Group	Date / Day	Timing
7, 8, 9 & 12	Monday 6 September	9am - 2pm
10, 11 & 13	Tuesday 7 September	9am - 2pm

Students will need to come to the schools Main Reception at any point during the above times on their year groups specific day. They will be registered and undertake their LFD in the schools Main Hall.

The 2nd LFD's will take place during the course of lessons later on in that 1st week. This will be communicated directly to students during Tutor Time.

What if the result is positive?

- Positive results will be shared directly with students and parents/carers will be informed by their Year Leaders.
- If a student tests positive using a LFD test, the student will need to self-isolate for 10 days in line with national guidance. In addition, students are required to take a confirmatory Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test. PCR tests must be arranged by yourself via a local NHS testing station.
- If the PCR test result is negative students can return to school.

Please remember, LFD testing is voluntary and can only be carried out with your consent.

Attendance:

- ✓ Students in Years 7 & 12 will return to school on Tuesday 7 September 2021.
- ✓ Students in all other year groups, plus Years 7 & 12, will return on Wednesday 8 September 2021.

Timetable:

Students in current Years 7 - 10 and 12 will be advised of their Tutor Group and Classroom when Academic Progress Reports are emailed home to parents / carers.

Students in Year 6 into Year 7 will be advised of their new Tutors in an email before September's start date.
