

**Overview:**

During this year, students complete their development of acting skills and put into practice their training on drama working methods, for the completion of the GCSE Drama

Students will complete their devised piece for Component 1 in response to a choice of stimuli. They will study a further play and develop an extract from this play for their Component 2 scripted performance for an external examiner.

They will also revise and prepare for the Component 3 written external exam, watching a piece of live theatre and developing their own production ideas for the set text as an actor and designer.



Year 11 Drama

Term 1:

You will continue work on your group devised piece of drama and prepare for a final performance for an audience.

You will keep a log book/portfolio which shows the creative process and your contribution to the overall development of the performance piece.

You will complete an evaluation under exam conditions, analysing the strengths and weaknesses of your performance

Term 2:

You will study a different play and select some script extracts to explore in small groups. From this you will prepare a performance for an external examiner, showcasing your physical and vocal skills especially related to characterisation.

You will go to watch a live theatre performance and spend time analysing the acting skills and the design concepts you saw.

You will take a mock written exam based on the set text you studied in year 10.

Term 3:

You will revise for your component 3 written exam, completing practice questions and learning key vocabulary ready for the paper.
