



## Student Behaviour in the Classroom

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Verbal Warnings</b></p> <p><b>Issued when:</b> disrupting learning. For example, continuing to talk when the teacher has requested students stop and listen and / or complete a task in silence.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>1<sup>st</sup> Comment</b></p> <p><b>Issued when:</b> behaviour that was requested to stop (verbal warning) continues <i>and</i> / <i>or</i> where a behaviour does not meet Headlands School's Behaviour for Learning standards.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>2<sup>nd</sup> Comment</b></p> <p><b>Issued when:</b> 1<sup>st</sup> Comment has been issued and behaviour(s) continue. Student will be moved within the classroom; teacher will talk to student at the end of the lesson <u>AND</u> teacher will call home. A detention will also be issued for the next day.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>3<sup>rd</sup> Comment</b></p> <p><b>Issued when:</b> 2<sup>nd</sup> Comment has been issued but the behaviour(s) continue. Student is therefore moved to another classroom.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Emergency Cover (E-Cov) (4<sup>th</sup> Comment)</b></p> <p>✓ If a student refuses to move to another classroom;  OR  ✓ When moved to another classroom the student continues to not meet Headlands School's Behaviour for Learning expectations;  OR  ✓ For a one off, significant incident in the classroom that is beyond the control of the teacher;</p> <p>The teacher will use Edulink to contact E-Cov and the student will be placed into Return to Learn for the remainder of the lesson.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Pride. Aspire. Respect.</b></p> <p><b>Pride:</b> wear your correct uniform to all lessons &amp; tutor. Wrong shoes = social times with Year Leader.</p> <p><b>Aspire:</b> positive attitude towards your learning in all lessons &amp; tutor. Arrive on time to school and lessons.</p> <p><b>Respect:</b> self-regulate behaviour(s) during social times and conduct yourselves in a polite and courteous manner at all times.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Return to Learn (R2L)</b></p> <p>6+ Comments = 1-day R2L  Any additional Comments above 6 within a week = additional day(s) in R2L  Refusal to follow staff instruction i.e. hand over Student Planner = 1 day R2L</p>
