Year 7 and 8

Rewards

- Super stamps work better than normal stamps
- Too many super stamps handed out
- Some teachers hand out lots of super stamps- some hand out none
- About 5 super stamps per lesson is good
- Routine stamps are good some think they should still be actual stamps
- Some teachers forget to put stamps on
- Some said they get postcards for things they do not need them for e.g. Breakfast club
- Gift cards for Cex and Primark on reds

Sanctions

- Consistency in who gets late marks

Over To Me (OTM)

- Some teachers are overly helpful and some do not help enough
- Some preferred challenge, super and turbo better you can do the level that's right for you
- Some think the challenge, super and turbo system should be integrated into OTM

Other

Rewards

Sanctions

- Seem to be too many suspensions
- Jewellery is too heavily focussed

- Some teachers are not using the sanction system properly and are not always giving warnings before going into sanctions (the respect is not going both ways)
- Year 11 non-uniform and use lanyards like sixth form?
