
After running a successful Disney Trip in 2019, we would like to offer this once again!

- Bags to go into the hold of the bus
- Students will need:
- Change of clothes
- Night-wear
- Toiletries please remember these will NOT be accessed unless in hotel
- Food/drinks for the return journey

Backpack

- Personal belongings such as phones/chargers (brought at own risk)
- Small toiletry items toothbrush, deodorant, wipes
- Water/food
- Spending money for food, souvenirs (We recommend no more than £100 (EUROS!) Students have responsibility for their own money
- Sun cream / hat
- Waterproof jacket
- Travel sickness pills



- Extra information:
- **DVDs** We would like to invite the students to bring a selection of their favourite DVD's (nothing over certificate 12) but would ask that the DVD boxes are clearly labelled with your child's name
- **Electrical Equipment** If your son / daughter plans to bring their mobile, Ipod, Ipad, handheld game console or camera then please remember to pack a charger and charger bank. Also please note that these items are not covered by the insurance and by bringing those, students do so at their own risk.
- Insurance Personal insurance can be purchased for around £5
- **Contact** We will post updates through our Facebook Page (when possible). Students will be given emergency numbers which staff will have at all times. Parents can contact school should they have any queries.
- **Disney park** Students will be in groups (they choose) and registered at certain times during the day. Students go around the park independently please



- Extra information:
- **Staff Numbers-** Students will have the emergency school mobile number so they can contact us through the day should they need to
- **Sleeping arrangements** Students will be in groups, these will be arranged before the trip. Students can choose who they share with under staff discretion (must be same gender). We won't be in the room for a long period of time. Students will know which rooms staff are in so they can be contacted in an emergency
- **First Aid/Medical** Students medical forms are already on school file, if you need to discuss medical conditions, please contact us. Students can carry and self administer own medications. (paracetamol, ibuprofen). Please ensure students bring their own inhalers.
- **Disneyland Paris app** encourage students to get this free app (if taking phone) to check wait times for rides/places to eat etc



Payment dates

- **Current Year 7-** A <u>non-refundable deposit of £100</u>, by <u>Monday 29 May, 2023</u> to be paid through Scopay secures a place on the trip. Another <u>compulsory payment of £100</u> will be due <u>Monday 31st July, 2023</u> The remaining balance of <u>£150</u> must be paid by <u>Friday 3rd May 2024</u>.
- **Current Year** 6 A <u>non-refundable deposit of £100</u>, by <u>Friday 29th September, 2023 to be paid through Scopay secures a place on the trip. Another <u>compulsory payment of £100</u> will be due <u>Friday 24th November</u>, 2023 The remaining balance of <u>£150</u> must be paid by <u>Friday 3rd May 2024</u>.</u>
- If full payment is not received by the deadline dates, your child will be removed from the trip and the money already paid will be forfeited.
