Feedback on proposed behaviour poster:

Behaviour: Showing Pride in yourself, Aspiring to be better, Respecting one another

Behaviour in the classroom—supporting positive learning environments		
Chance to change	This gives students an opportunity to self-correct their behaviour before any formal intervention.	E.g. Talking out of turn, being off task, disrupting the learning of others
First Comment	This addresses continued behaviour after the initial chance to change, allowing further reflection.	E.g. Repeatedly talking out of turn, being off task, disrupting the learning of others, swearing
Second Comment	This addresses persistent behaviour issues and allows further reflection, A YL detention is issued.	E.g. Continuing to talk out of turn, being off task, disrupting the learning of others
Remove room	Students are removed to another room to reflect and prevent further disruption to learning.	E.g. Continuing to talk out of turn, being off task, disrupting the learning of others
E-Cover	Students are collected by senior staff. Taken to Return to Learn for a period of time.	E.g. Refusal to go to remove room, behaviour that poses a risk to the safety of others.

Mobile phones are not allowed to be seen or heard on school site. This is gate to gate so includes any time on school site. If you are seen with your phone this will be confiscated by staff and placed in the safe for the day. If you need to contact your parents at any time, student services can help you with this.

Lateness

Lateness to school or lessons will be marked on the register.
2 AM late marks or 4 lesson late marks will result in an SLT detention.

Uniform

- Black blazer with school logo
- Headlands School tie with black and red stripe
- Plain, collared white shirt
- All black, flat shoes
- Plain black trousers with pockets
- Black or grey tailored shorts
- Grey, pleated knee length skirt
- Jewellery—One pair of simple studded earrings only. One wrist watch is permitted.
- Only discreet make up is allowed. No blusher, contour, eye shadow, lip-stick, lip liner, eye liner, eye brow pencil or false eye-lashes. Nail polish, False nails are not allowed

Sanctions for misbehaviour	
Year Leader Detention (T/W/Th)	Issued for 2 comments in 1 lesson, or more serious misbehaviour. Students will reflect on the behaviour that led to the detention.
SLT Detention (Friday)	Issued for refusal to attend YL detention, persistent lateness to school or lessons, or serious misbehaviour. Students will reflect on the behaviour that led to the detention.
Return to Learn (8:30-3:15)	This addresses persistent behaviour issues. It is a removal from normal lessons. Issued for 6,8,10 comments in a week or more serious misbehaviour.
Internal Exclusion (8:30-3:45)	Issued for significant misbehaviour. These behaviours are deemed too serious for a RTL but not as serious as a fixed term suspension.
FTS	Issued for serious misbehaviour. Students will be suspended from school for a period of days. This is the most serious sanction in the school before permanent exclusion.

What students like:

- Clear and visual
- Very useful for students as well as staff
- Really helps to clarify any misunderstandings

Student's suggestions on alterations:

- Typo in the uniform part in the jewellery section 'One wrist watch is per-...'. Seems like something is missing.
- Will need printing large and clear so that all the information can be read - particularly the attendance chart which is good but not easy to read in it's current form. This might be just because the current format is electronic.

- It would ideally have less words on it so that it is easier for everyone to read each section but this may lose some of the important information.
- Clarification may be needed around what the abbreviations mean e.g. FTS
- ‘talking out of turn’ might not be understood by all students. Something like ‘talking over the teacher/peers’ may work
