

Headlands School students part of groundbreaking leadership project





Under the guidance of Headlands teachers – Miss Matthews and Mrs Adamson – and in association with Andrea from the ERYC's Anti-Social Behaviour Team, the NextGenLeaders Programme is a youth leadership initiative aimed at empowering young individuals to become responsible leaders through project-based learning and youth participatory action.

Said Mrs Adamson: "It gives students from Year 7 onwards the chance to work on real-life projects and take part in activities where they can make a difference.

"The programme helps them build important skills like curiosity, creativity, and empathy while solving real-world problems.

"As part of the ERYC's anti-social behaviour week, projects have focused on groups like 'young neurodivergent individuals', 'youth at risk of knife crime', 'homeless people who need access to period products', and 'young carers'.

"NextGenLeaders projects impacted over 7,000 beneficiaries, and we are eager to see the contributions that this year's Changemakers at Headlands School will make." added Andrea.
