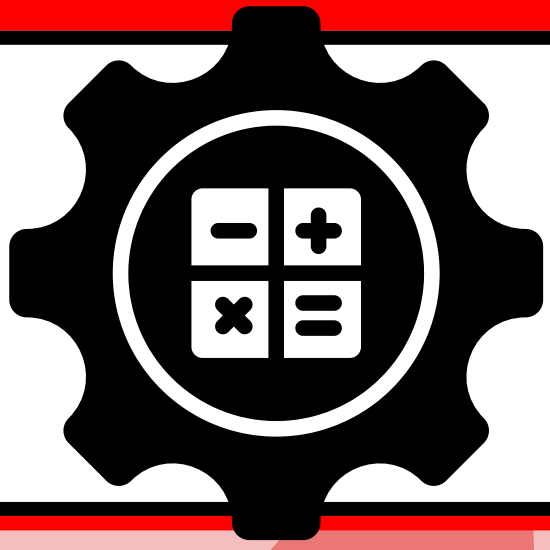

WHERE WORDS MEET NUMBERS

1

- **Timelines** - used in historical context or plot sequencing in novels, plays, and biographies.
- **Statistics in non-fiction** - interpreting data in persuasive writing. For example, in newspaper articles, speeches and leaflets.
- **Reading charts and graphs** - understanding info texts, reviews, and reports.
- **Quantitative language** - identifying and analysing numbers, ratios, and percentages.

WRITING WITH NUMBERS

2

- **Using data for impact** - “9 out of 10 people...” - helps create persuasive arguments.
- **Accurate numerical references** - writing numbers correctly in formal texts. For example, ‘twenty’ vs. ‘20’.
- **Estimating and Comparing** - making reasoned judgements when evaluating texts or making inferences.

ANALYTICAL SKILLS

3

- **Interpreting patterns** - repetition, motifs, and structure. For example, syllables in poetry, rhetorical devices etc.
- **Ranking and ordering** - evaluating importance of themes, events, or character actions.
- **Proportional reasoning** - For example, analysing how much dialogue a character has or the length of a scene.
