



Headlands School Uniform Policy

All students in Years 7-11 are expected to wear school uniform. We look to parents to support us in maintaining good standards of dress. Wearing school uniform encourages a positive attitude to school and work. The information below describes Headlands School Uniform requirements.

Black blazer with school logo*
Headlands School tie in red and black stripe
Plain, collared white shirt
Black Trousers with pockets
Black flat shoes
Black or Grey Tailored Shorts**
Grey pleated knee length skirt

*Headlands School will provide students with a free iron-on logo. Blazers **are** compulsory.

** Summer Term only

Jewellery

One simple pair of small studded earrings only. Discrete clear plastic retainers are permitted for piercings. No other jewellery is permitted.

Headteachers discretion to be made in respect of jewellery regarding recognised religious instruction (i.e. religions that are recognised as major world religions)

- A wrist watch is permitted

Outdoor Coats:

Students may wear an appropriate *outdoor coat* over their blazer to and from school and during break times. An outdoor coat must be a weather-resistant garment made from suitable outerwear material (e.g. waterproof or padded fabric) and designed to be worn over a blazer. Hoodies, sweatshirts, tracksuit tops, or garments made from jersey or fleece material are not appropriate coats and are not permitted.

Make up

Only discreet make up is allowed. Students cannot wear blusher, contour, eye shadow, lipstick, lip liner, eye liner, eye brow pencil or false eyelashes. Nail polish, gel, acrylic or other forms of false nails are not allowed.

Students should not dye their hair unnatural or bright hair colours.

Adaptations

Students have always tried to adapt the school uniform to their individual tastes, it is important that we maintain a standard uniform. The following are examples of such adaptations and **are not allowed**:

Trousers - denim, canvas, joggers, leggings

Skirts -non-pleated, lycra, excessively short, black

Shoes - trainers with logos, stripes, boots of any kind, canvas pumps, coloured sidewalls, piping

Tights - footless or skin coloured

In addition, students will often add fashion belts, large ear rings, bangles, wrist bands, beads, necklaces and a variety of hats. These are also **not allowed** - appropriate hats can be worn outside the school building when the weather is cold. Baseball style caps are **not permitted** in the school grounds.

Technology Food - Bib apron with large black and white check

Resistant Materials - Bib apron, plain beige or with school logo

Polo shirt: Plain Red

Rugby shirt/ sweatshirt/ hoodie: Plain Black or Red

Shorts or Skort: Plain black

Training trousers: Plain black running leggings (not cotton) - the wearing of training trousers will depend on the activity

Socks: Plain Red football socks (outdoors) / white tennis/ankle socks (indoors and Summer outdoors)

Footwear: Trainers/ football boots

Polo Shirt: Plain Red

Rugby shirt/ Sweatshirt/ hoodie: Plain Black or Red

Shorts: Plain black shorts

Training trousers: Plain black - the wearing of training trousers will depend on the activity

Socks: Plain Red football socks (outdoors) / white tennis/ankle socks (indoors and summer outdoors)

Footwear: Trainers/ football boots

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If Parents are in any doubt they should contact their child's Head of Year before purchasing any item.

Summer PE Kit

PE Kit is compulsory even if students are not actively participating in the lesson.

During the summer term both boys and girls may wear white ankle or tennis socks instead of the plain red football socks. Please note that if playing for a school football team, School BLACK shorts and long red socks must be worn.
