SUMMER REWARDS ACTIVITIES

As we build up towards the Summer Rewards trips we have set the thresholds for the stages on the rewards ladder.

Stage 4 (Year Leader Certificate) = 3500

Stage 5 (Pastoral Manager Certificate) = 4000

Stage 6 (Summer Activity 1) = 4500

Stage 7 (Choice between Summer Activity 1 or 2) = 5000

Stage 8 (SLT Certificate and choice between Summer Activity 1, 2 or 3) = 5500

Stage 9 (Headteachers Certificate) = 7500

Stage 10 (Governor Certificate) = 8000

Summer Activity 1 - in school reward including non uniform and the opportunity to attend a disco or other in school activities.

Summer Activity 2 - the first 160 students to get to this threshold and choose this activity will have a day at the Forum for bowling and the cinema.

Summer Activity 3 - the first 250 students to get to this threshold and choose this activity will have a day at Flamingo Land.

The costs to these activities will be kept as low as possible.

Students are invited to these activities on Achievement Points but if attendance or behaviour is not seen as acceptable by the Year Leader, then the student will not be eligible.

A lot of achievement points can be gained in 2 and a bit months, especially with the attendance and punctuality boosts!
